

LCI Movement Program Guide

Early Childhood Music and Movement Workshops (Pre School)

This program emphasizes the creation and exploration of music and movement for the little movers in your life. Children are encouraged to get on their feet, sing and dance along to some of their favourite tunes. This program can be done in a single day session or in on an ongoing contract.

Curriculum Based Workshops (Kindergarten – Grade 6)

This program is designed to meet the expectations of the K-6 Ontario dance curriculum. This program is exploratory based, and is completed through mini activities and group performances to encourage creativity, growth and comfort with movement. This program can be conducted in a single day, or multi-day workshop, depending on the number of expectations the teacher is hoping to cover.

Creativity Based Workshops (Grade 1 – 12)

This program pushes students to explore their creative side. After learning a small movement piece from an instructor, groups will be tasked with finishing the choreography using their own dance moves. This program is run in a single day session where each group requires about 1 hour of instruction.

Introduction to Performance (Grade 4 – 12)

This program introduces students to both singing and dancing. Students will learn the vocals of a pop song, and a dance routine to go with it. This program is run in a single day session, requiring at least half a day per group, depending on the number of students.

Performance Choreography (All Grades)

This program gives teachers the opportunity to hire externally for choreography for student performances. Whether it be choreography for an upcoming competition, in house performance, graduation, musical, etc. Our choreographers work alongside the director in order to bring their vision to life.

Youth Leadership Development Workshops (Grade 6 – 12)

This program introduces students to leadership traits and skills that are transferable throughout their future education and career. This program is activity based and allows students hands on activities to enhance their leadership skills through engaging activities, insightful discussion and thoughtful reflection.

Professional Development Workshops (Teachers)
